Duties: Serves as a recognized authority on selected regional foreign military Command, Control, Communications, and Computers, Intelligence/Electronic Warfare (C4IEW). Represents 1st IO Cmd to NSA & IOTC offices and performs liaison within NSA & IOTC for both policy and analytic matters. Conducts detailed, all-source research and analysis of Foreign C4IEW systems and doctrine to determine capabilities/vulnerabilities. Interfaces directly with National Foreign Intelligence Community (NFIC), including service intelligence components. Serves as a Senior Technical Expert responsible for: (a) initiating/conducting independent research; (b) providing expert threat assessments, forecasts, projections to drive Echelon Above Corps material acquisition, concepts of operations, doctrine, tactics, and organization. Represents 1st IO Cmd on specific country and technology working groups within NSA & IOTC and the Intelligence Community (IC). Functions as technical supervisor for approximately 4 personnel.

- Applicants claiming Veterans Preference must submit required paperwork at the time of selection. Must be able to obtain and maintain a TOP SECRET Special Access security clearance as a result of a current and favorable Special Background Investigation and successful counterintelligence (CI) polygraph examination. Temporary duty to worldwide locations may constitute up to 25% of the time. Specialized experience is experience in planning, organizing, and coordinating intelligence research and analysis; initiating, organizing, and applying new methods and approaches in support of developing complex solutions to intelligence problems; knowledge of current IO directives and polices; technical/operational intelligence SME on specified foreign nations/geographic areas and/or specific functional areas.

- GG-12 and above: One year of specialized experience directly related to the position being filled and equivalent to the next lower grade level. There is no substitution of education for experience at this level.
- Progressively responsible experience is that which has included intelligence-related research, analysis, collections and /or operations. At the GS-11 level and above it should have included intelligence analysis and/or production, intelligence collection and/or operations, counterintelligence, or threat support directly related to the position to be filled. Creditable specialized experience may include previous military intelligence experience, experience gained in the private sector or in another government agency as long as it was at a level at least equivalent to the next lower grade in the series. This experience should demonstrate: Knowledge of intelligence processes, cycle and organizations; Knowledge of and/or ability to use research tools such as library holdings, photographs, statistics, graphics and maps; Knowledge of the systems, procedures and methods of analyzing, compiling, reporting and disseminating intelligence data; and/or Knowledge of organization(s) for and methods of collecting and analyzing intelligence data.
