Manages and assists in the processing, maintenance, and quality control of technical data residing in a variety of databases. As Senior Analyst, directs SIGINT analytic efforts throughout the entire production process, from collection and targeting to multi-stage selection, processing, and reporting. Understands the United States SIGINT System (USSS), United States Signals Intelligence Directives (USSIDs), Intelligence Oversight, and all facets of Information Operations, focusing on Computer Network Operations. Possesses broad knowledge of global telecommunications technologies and methodologies, computer networks, security, hardware, and operating systems. Supervises civilian and military; provides technical guidance to assigned contractor personnel performing a variety of SIGINT, IO and CNO support functions.

Specialized experience is experience in managing SIGINT collection requirements and extensive expertise in developing SIGINT collection plans and strategies, IO planning and intelligence efforts for support to Strategic, Operational and Tactical levels. Experience in Telecommunications network architecture and protocols (Switches, Multiplexers, ATM, Frame Relay, ISDN, etc.), Global Network management (LANs, MANs, WANs, FDDI, etc.), Link Protocols (routing, switching, Ethernet, SLDC, HDLC, etc.), Internet Protocols (TCP/IP, UDP, BGP, DNS, SMTP, etc.), Cryptography and encryption tools (PGP, etc.)
