Commits resources and obligates the organization to new directions fulfilling objectives/policies. Analyzes plans and intelligence information to assess developments, trends and threat implications within assigned geographical/functional areas. Reviews annexes to OPLANS/CONPLANS. Provides backup support to field support teams. Supervises regional planners for EUCOM, PACOM, CENTCOM, SOUTHCOM and STRATCOM. Conducts Information Operations and Command and Control Warfare analysis and targeting within assigned areas. Supervises civilian, military and contract employees performing a variety of IO mission support functions. Performs the full range of supervisory duties.

- *Applicants claiming Veterans Preference must submit required paperwork at the time of selection. *Must be able to acquire and maintain a TOP SECRET Special Access security clearance as a result of a current and favorable Special Background Investigation (SBI). *Temporary duty to worldwide locations may be required up to 25 % of the time. *Specialized experience is experience in organizational principles and practices relating to Department of the Army's process to integrate Information Operations (IO) capabilities into active and reserve components. Experience with Army, DOD, and Joint I/O concepts and doctrine, supporting complex research development, acquisition, and training programs.

- GG-12 and above: One year of specialized experience directly related to the position being filled and equivalent to the next lower grade level. There is no substitution of education for experience at

this level.

- Progressively responsible experience is that which has included intelligence-related research, analysis, collections and /or operations. At the GS-11 level and above it should have included intelligence analysis and/or production, intelligence collection and/or operations, counterintelligence, or threat support directly related to the position to be filled. Creditable specialized experience may include previous military intelligence experience, experience gained in the private sector or in another government agency as long as it was at a level at least equivalent to the next lower grade in the series. This experience should demonstrate: Knowledge of intelligence processes, cycle and organizations; Knowledge of and/or ability to use research tools such as library holdings, photographs, statistics, graphics and maps; Knowledge of the systems, procedures and methods of analyzing, compiling, reporting and disseminating intelligence data; and/or Knowledge of organization(s) for and methods of collecting and analyzing intelligence data.
