Supervises civilian, military, and contract employees performing a variety of IO mission support functions. Provides technical guidance in performing all phases of IO courseware development and in outlining systematic steps and processes. Identifies training and professional development necessary to acquire and sustain requisite skills, knowledge, and abilities in emerging IO technology, doctrine, and training. Formulates and integrates the Program of Instruction (POI) for courses in concert with Army IO and doctrine training. Ensures all courses fully integrate every aspect of IO. Develops, coordinates and communicates public affairs policies, programs and activities.

The ability to plan and conduct evaluation studies, design IO training scenarios and prepare long-range training resource plans.
- GS-12 and above: One year of experience directly related to the occupation and equivalent to at least the next lower grade level. There is no substitution of education for experience at this level.
